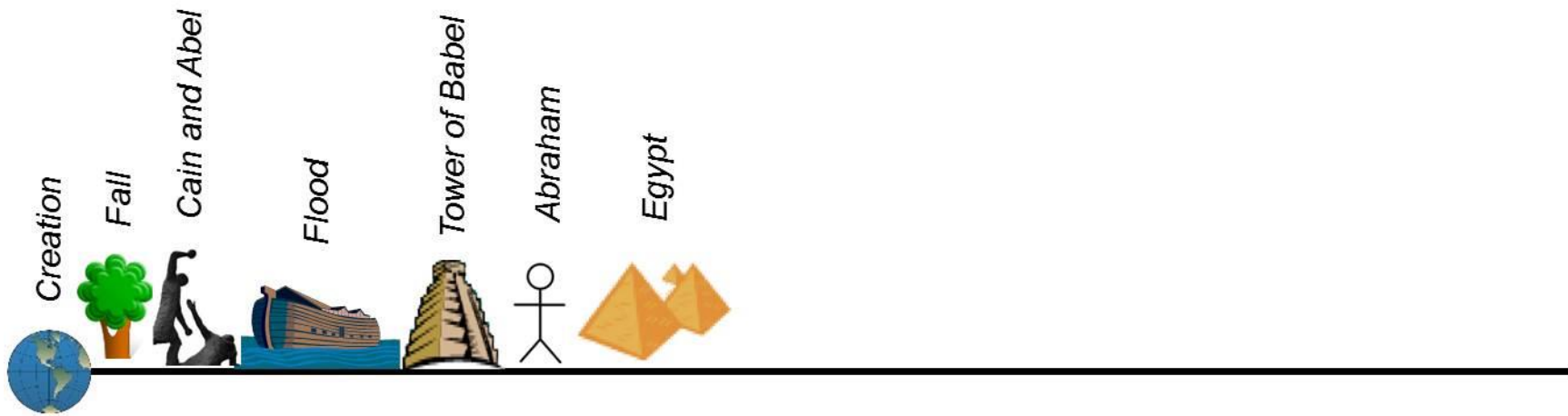
## Lesson 7

Pharaoh is a willing follower of God's adversary, opposing God and His people Israel.

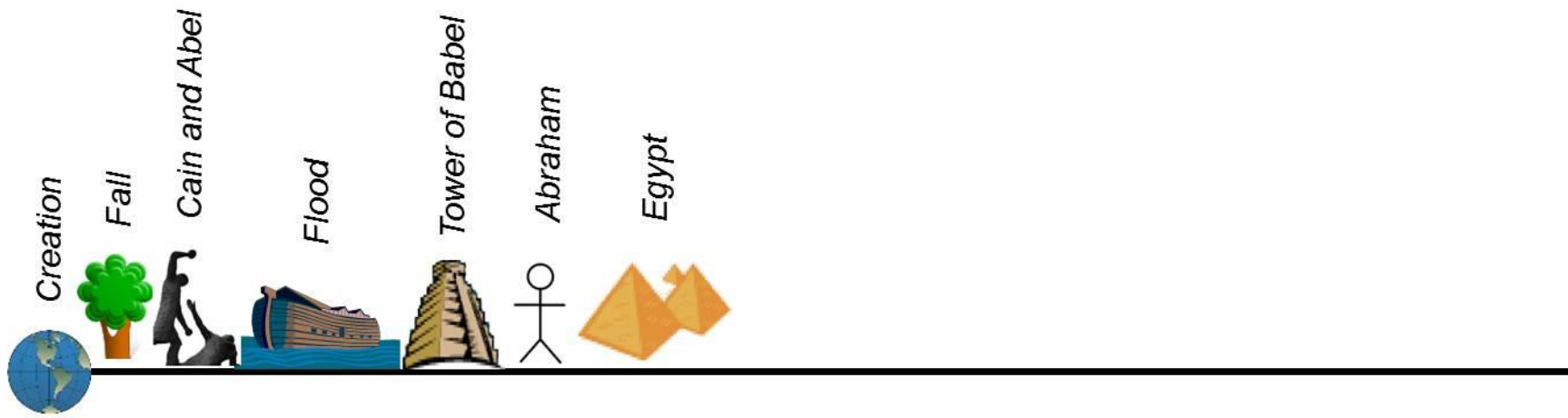
Given the right circumstance, this man's heart becomes hard.

Defiance...      Battle of wills



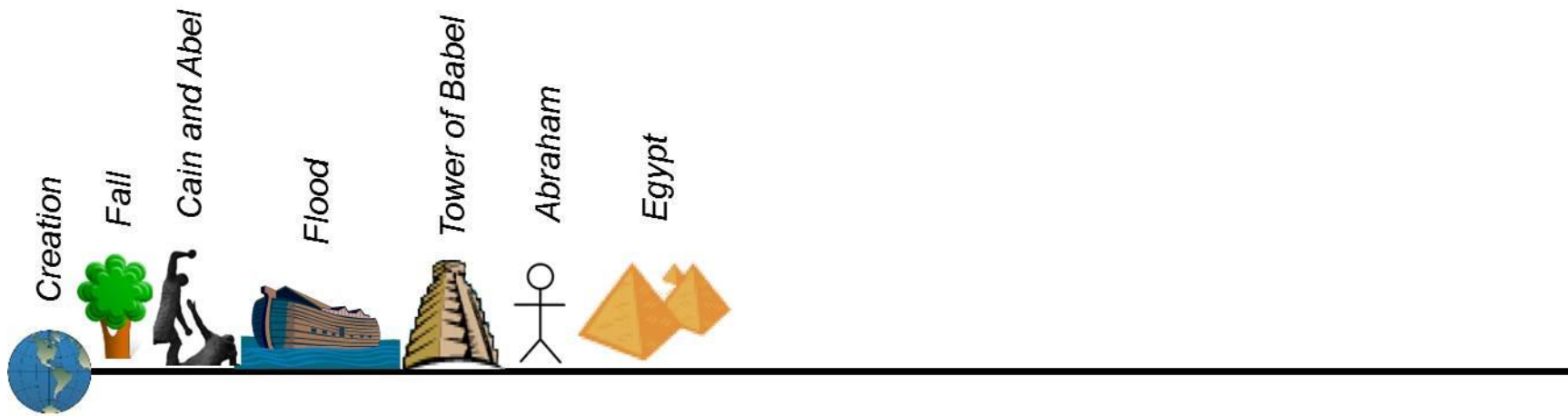


First three Signs Pharaoh's magicians imitate.
