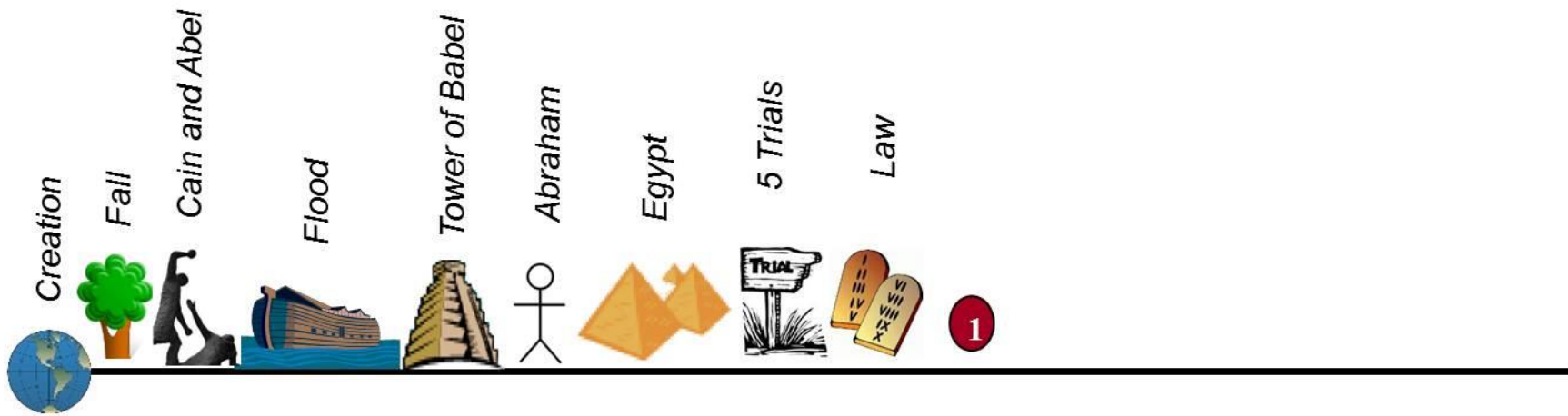

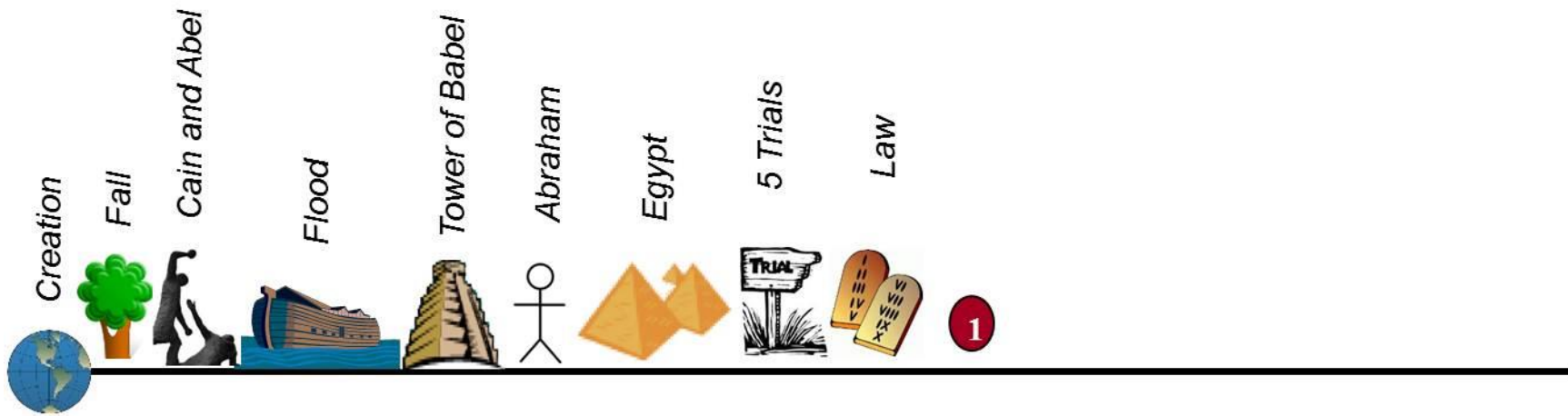

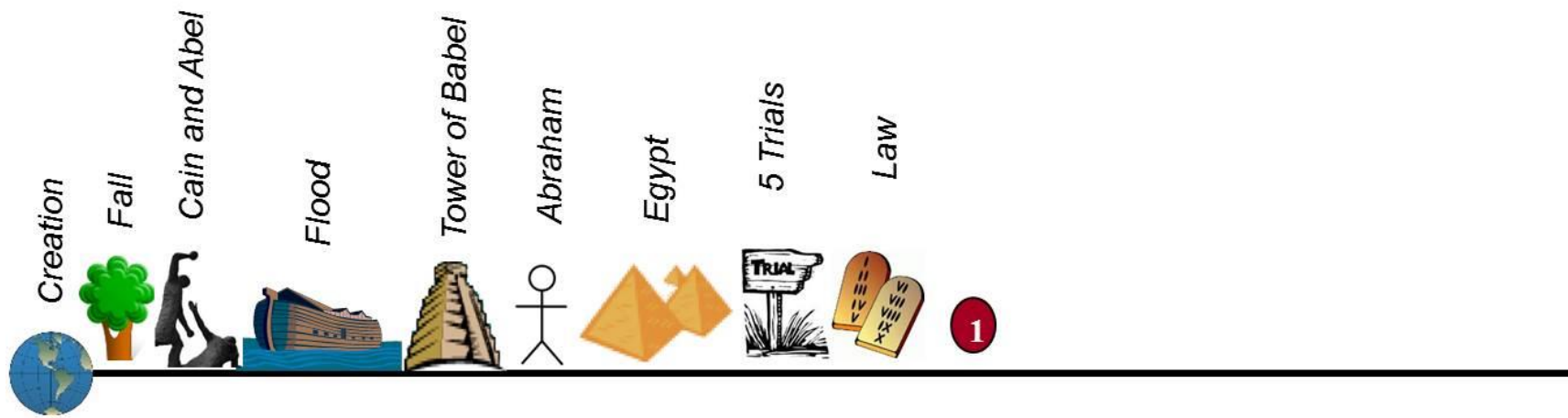


Ruth

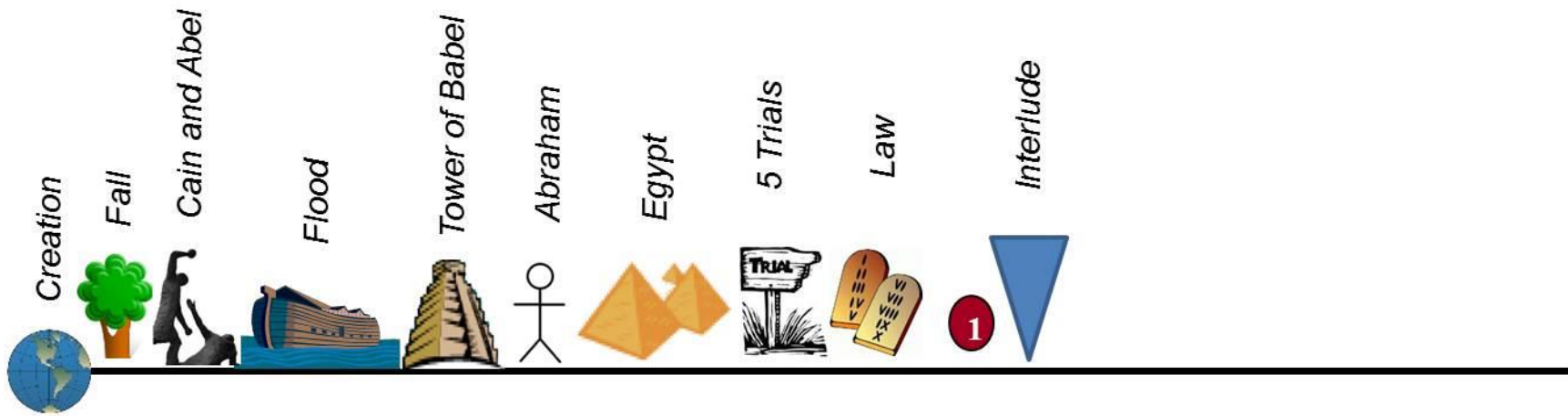
