Summary of the Good News:

- 1. Essential Circumstance
- 2. Universally Available
- 3. Limited Application: Believers

Man's
Condemnation

for there is no difference:

for all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

God's Solution

being justified freely

by His grace

through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

(cont.) redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

God's Solution is Universal

whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation

through faith in His blood,

to declare His righteousness

for the remission of sins that are past,

through the forbearance of God;

God's Righteousness Manifested and Applied to any Believer

to declare, I say, at this time his righteousness:

that he might be just,

and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

Where is boasting then?

It is excluded.

By what law? of works? Nay:
but by the law of faith.

Men's Mouths are Still Stopped:

Works are excluded at all times, to all people, in any dispensation, any program, so that men never boast before God.

Therefore we conclude that a man is justified

by faith

without the deeds of the law.

Means of Appropriation is Faith Alone
